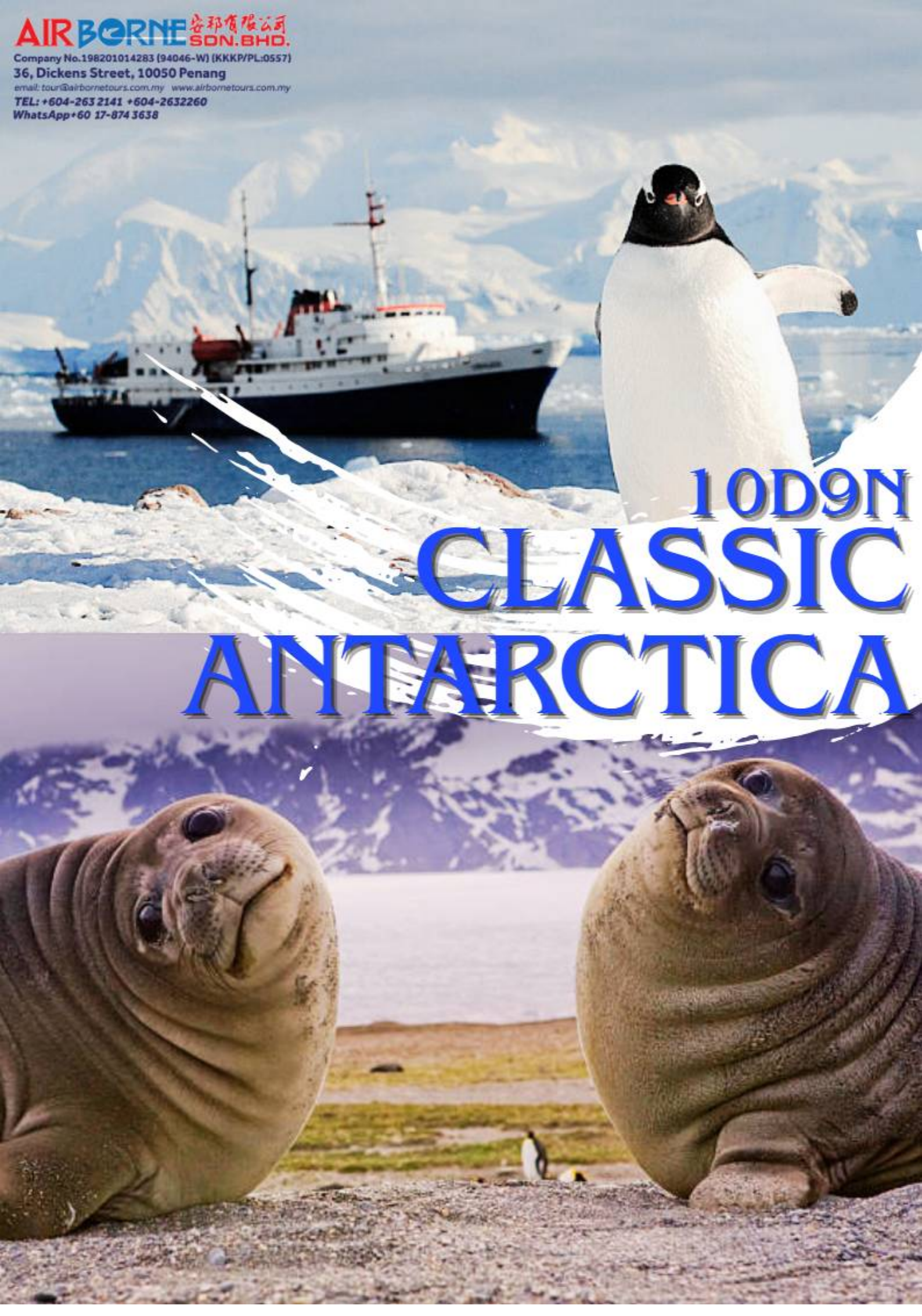

Expedition cruise to the Antarctic Peninsula & South Shetland Islands.

Visit the last pristine region of the world. Antarpply Expeditions "Classic Antarctica" voyage is the ultimate introduction to the White Continent.

Day 1 Embark Expedition cruise in Ushuaia

(D)

Embark the M.V. USHUAIA ship in the afternoon and meet your expedition and lecture staff. After you have settled into your cabins we sail along the famous Beagle Channel and the scenic Mackinlay Pass.

Days 2 & 3 Crossing the Drake Passage

(B, L, D)

The Drake Passage marks the Antarctic Convergence, a biological barrier where cold polar water sinks beneath the warmer northern waters. This creates a great upwelling of nutrients, which sustains the biodiversity of this region. The Drake Passage also marks the northern limit of many Antarctic seabirds.

As we sail across the passage, Antarpply Expeditions' lecturers will be out with you on deck to help in the identification of an amazing variety of seabirds, including many albatrosses, which follow in our wake. The USHUAIA's open bridge policy allows you to join our officers on the bridge and learn about navigation, watch for whales, and enjoy the view. A full program of lectures will be offered as well.

The first sightings of icebergs and snow-capped mountains indicate that we have reached the South Shetland Islands, a group of twenty islands and islets. With favorable conditions in the Drake Passage our lecturers and naturalists will accompany you ashore as you experience your first encounter with the penguins and seals on Day 3.

Days 4 to 7 Exploring the Antarctic Peninsula & South Shetland Islands

(B, L, D)

The South Shetland Islands are a haven for wildlife. Vast penguin rookeries, beaches ruled by Antarctic fur seals and Southern elephant seals make every day spent in this amazing island group unforgettable. Sailing through the narrow passage into the flooded caldera of Deception Island is breathtaking.

King George Island, the largest of the South Shetland Islands, features colonies of nesting Gentoo and Chinstrap Penguins, Kelp Gulls, Blue-eyed Cormorants, Antarctic Terns and Southern Giant Petrels and is home to scientific bases of many different countries. Chinstrap and Gentoo Penguins as well as elephant seals await you at Livingston Island.

The Antarctic Peninsula's remarkable history will provide you with a type of excitement often only associated with the early explorers. You will have plenty of time to explore its amazing scenery, a pristine wilderness of snow, ice, mountains and waterways, and an incredible wide variety of wildlife. Apart from penguins and seabirds you are very likely to see Weddell, crabeater and leopard seals as well as Minke, killer (orca) and humpback whales at close range.

We hope to navigate some of the most beautiful waterways (depending on the ice conditions): the Gerlache Strait, the Neumayer Channel, and the Lemaire Channel, the latter are narrow passages between towering rock faces and spectacular glaciers. We plan to make at least two landings per day and possible landing sites may include:



Paradise Bay is perhaps the most aptly named place in the world and we attempt a landing on the continent proper. After negotiating the iceberg-strewn waters of the Antarctic Sound, we hope to visit the bustling Adélie Penguin (over 100,000 pairs breed here) and Blue-eyed Cormorant colonies on Paulet Island. The Nordenskjöld expedition built a stone survival hut here in 1903. Today its ruins have been taken over by nesting penguins.

Further exploration may take you to the Melchior Island group, Cuverville Island, Portal Point, Neko Harbour, Pléneau Island and if ice conditions permit, to Petermann Island for a visit to the southernmost colony of Gentoo Penguins.

Days 8 & 9 At Sea crossing the Drake Passage, North Bound (B, L, D)

Leave Antarctica and head north across the Drake Passage. Join our lecturers and naturalists on deck as we search for seabirds and whales and enjoy some final lectures. Take the chance to relax and reflect on the fascinating adventures of the past days on the way back to Ushuaia.

Days 10 Arrival in Ushuaia (B)

Arrive at the port of Ushuaia in the early morning and disembark ship.

Please note: The above itinerary is a guide only. Our exact route and program will vary to take best advantage of local weather and ice conditions and opportunities to view wildlife. Changes will be made by the Captain and/or Expedition Leader to facilitate the best results from the prevailing conditions. A daily program sheet will be issued on board. Flexibility is the key to success.

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10天9晚 经典南极之旅



南极半岛与南设得兰群岛探险邮轮 (Expedition Cruise to the Antarctic Peninsula & South Shetland Islands)

探索世界最后一片净土! Antarpplly Expeditions 推出的「经典南极之旅 Classic Antarctica」是您认识白色大陆的理想首航。

第1天: 阿根廷乌斯怀亚登船 (晚餐)

下午登上探险船 M.V. USHUAIA, 与探险队员与讲师团队会面。安顿好船舱后, 我们将穿越著名的比格尔海峡 (Beagle Channel) 与美丽的麦金莱海峡 (Mackinlay Pass), 开启探险航程。

第2-3天: 穿越德雷克海峡 (早/午/晚餐)

德雷克海峡是南极辐合带所在地, 冷极海水下沉于温暖海水之下, 营养物质涌升, 使这里成为极其富饶的生态区域, 也是多种海鸟的北界。

在穿越海峡时, 探险讲师将陪同您在甲板观鸟, 有机会看到多种信天翁、海燕等南极海鸟。您也可前往船桥, 了解航海知识、寻找鲸鱼、欣赏海上美景。期间亦将安排一系列精彩讲座。

进入南设得兰群岛海域后, 若天气允许, 我们将在第3天下午首次登陆, 亲密接触南极企鹅与海豹!

第4-7天: 探索南极半岛与南设得兰群岛 (早/午/晚餐)

南设得兰群岛 是野生动物的天堂。成群的企鹅栖息地、毛皮海豹与象海豹在海滩上悠然活动。航行穿越迪塞普逊岛 (Deception Island) 火山口的狭窄通道将是令人惊叹的经历。

乔治王岛 (King George Island) 是南设得兰群岛最大岛屿, 栖息着大量帽带企鹅、巴布亚企鹅、海鸥、蓝眼鸬鹚、南极燕鸥和南极巨鲑, 并设有多国科考基地。

利文斯顿岛 (Livingston Island): 可见帽带企鹅、巴布亚企鹅与象海豹。

南极半岛 的历史让人联想起早期极地探险的浪漫与艰辛。这里是冰雪、山脉与水道交错的荒野天堂, 您将有机会亲眼见到多种野生动物, 如威德尔海豹、食蟹海豹、豹海豹, 以及近距离观察小须鲸、虎鲸 (杀人鲸)、座头鲸等。

我们希望穿越以下著名水道 (视冰况而定):

格拉汉姆海峡 (Gerlache Strait)

诺伊梅尔海峡 (Neumayer Channel)

勒梅尔海峡 (Lemaire Channel): 被称为“南极天堂之门”, 两侧耸立着岩石与冰川。

我们预计每日安排两次登陆, 可能的登陆点包括:

天堂湾 Paradise Bay: 或许是世界上最贴切其名的地方, 您将踏上南极大陆本土!

企鹅岛 Paulet Island: 超过10万对阿德利企鹅繁殖于此, 蓝眼鸬鹚同样常见。岛上有1903年 Nordenskjöld 探险队的石屋遗迹, 如今已被企鹅占据。

其他登陆点: Melchior 群岛、Cuverville 岛、Portal Point、Neko 港、Pléneau 岛, 以及若冰况允许, 前往最南端的巴布亚企鹅栖息地——彼得曼岛 Petermann Island。

第8-9天: 北上返航, 穿越德雷克海峡 (早/午/晚餐)

告别南极, 北上穿越德雷克海峡。您可继续与自然讲师一同在甲板寻找海鸟与鲸鱼, 参加讲座, 并在旅程尾声放松休息、回顾难忘的南极探险。

第10天: 抵达乌斯怀亚港, 结束航程 (早餐)

清晨抵达阿根廷乌斯怀亚港口, 办理离船手续。
