### Morning game drive and transfer to Ishasha sector

Your journey continues deeper into Queen Elizabeth, heading south into the legendary Ishasha sector. This is the land of the tree-climbing lions and your eyes scan the fig trees where these elusive predators lounge in regal fashion. As evening falls, you venture out again on a **game drive**, where the golden light spills across the







savannah, painting unforgettable scenes of buffalo herds and wandering elephants.

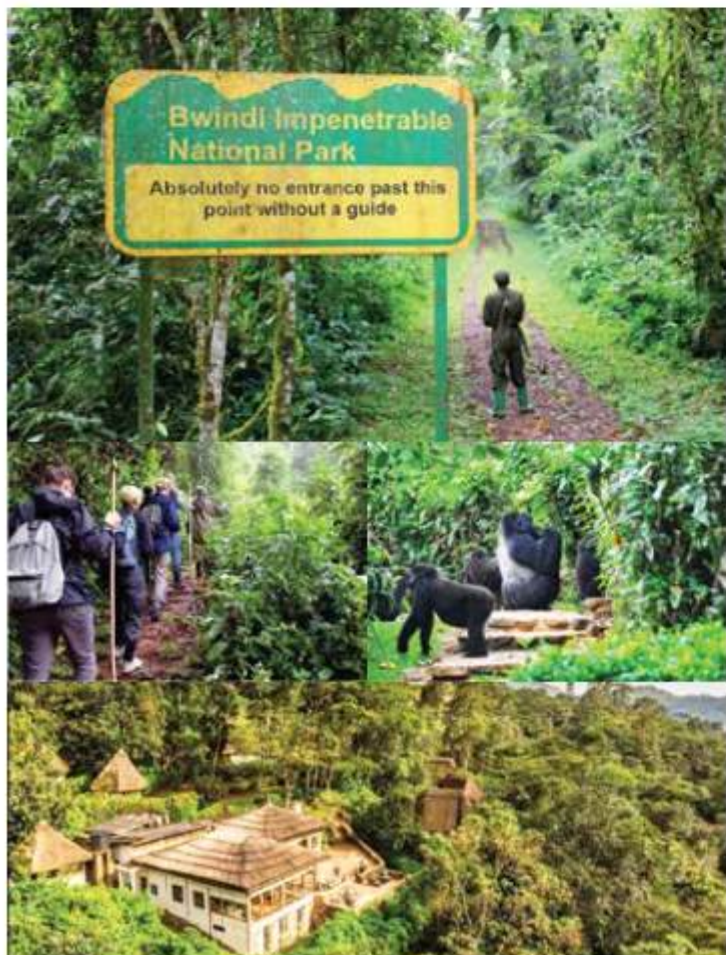


## Day 06

### QUEEN ELIZABETH NATIONAL PARK – BWINDI IMPENETRABLE NATIONAL PARK (2N)

 Hotel Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner

Travel into the misty highlands, the road winding up into the ancient rainforest of **Bwindi Impenetrable National Park**. The focal point of Uganda's famed Gorilla Highlands, there exists about one half of the world's population of the endangered mountain gorillas. This is the richest forest in Uganda, in terms of the number of plant species, as the area is one of the few large expanses of forest in East Africa where lowland and mountain communities merge. The journey itself is a story, each turn revealing terraced hills, tea plantations, and mountain vistas. Tomorrow you step into one of the greatest adventures on earth.



## Day 07

### BWINDI IMPENETRABLE NATIONAL PARK – GORILLA TREKKING

 Hotel Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner

An early start, head to the Headquarters of **Bwindi Impenetrable Forest National Park** for orientation as well as separation into the groups base on which gorilla trekking group you are to be tracking.



Trek into the forest on the slopes of the volcanoes, led by experienced trackers will bring you amongst a family of **Mountain Gorillas**. These massive primates are extremely rare. You will get within meters of the family and be privileged to spend time (approx. one hour) amongst them.



The tracking / trekking (up to six hours or longer is not uncommon) can entail climbing as well as hiking; although when you come face to face with the tranquil yet potent Mountain Gorillas, observing the massive silverback, baby with the mothers, the gorillas partaking their everyday routine just right in front of you is all very overwhelming.

In the late afternoon (time permitting), you walk through the community, meeting local people whose traditions are as rich as the forest around them.





## Day 08

### BWINDI NATIONAL PARK – LAKE KIVU, RWANDA (1N)

Hotel Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner

Travel to **Lake Kivu, Rwanda**. Part of Africa's Great Rift Valley, **Lake Kivu** shared by Rwanda and DRC, is surrounded by magnificent mountains and has deep emerald green waters.



Leave Uganda behind and cross into Rwanda via the Cyanika border, each mile carrying you closer to Lake Kivu's serene shores. By afternoon, you glide across the lake on a **boat cruise**, the waters reflecting volcanic peaks in the distance. The cool breeze, the fishing canoes, and the rhythm of Rwandan life enchant you as evening settles in.

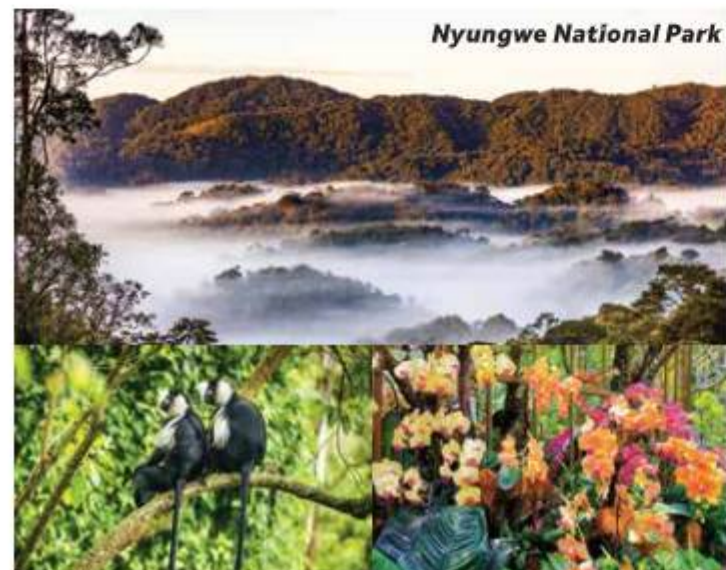


## Day 09

### LAKE KIVU – NYUNGWE NATIONAL PARK (1N)

Hotel Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner

**Walk among the Tree Tops at Nyungwe National Park** which sprawls scenically across the rolling hills of southwest Rwanda. See giant buttressed mahoganies and other ancient hardwood trees, tangled vines adorned with flowers, and some of the park's 200-odd orchid species.



Suspended above a ravine in the lush montane rainforest of **Nyungwe National Park**, the **canopy walkway** provides an exhilarating perspective on the ancient treetops and wildlife. The 160m long and 70m high suspension bridge will enable you to see a variety of colorful forest birds and monkeys on the rewarding trail, but the main attraction for most of our guests is a suspended canopy walk that offers a unique bird's-eye perspective over the forest floor and into the treetops.



## Day 10

### NYUNGWE NATIONAL PARK – KIGALI (1N)

Hotel Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner

Journey towards Rwanda's capital. Along the way, stop in **Butare** to explore the **Ethnographic Museum**, where the rich traditions and history of Rwanda unfold before you in stories, artifacts, and cultural treasures. The drive continues until Kigali greets you with its hills, its lights, and its welcoming spirit.



## Day 11

### KIGALI ✈️ BUJUMBURA, BURUNDI (2N)

Hotel Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner

Visit **Kigali Genocide Memorial**, one of the numerous burial grounds and popular local tourist attraction where large number of genocide victims were buried after the killings. Explore the facility as the guide tells you the whole story and key events leading to this tragedy that shook the whole of Rwanda.

Transfer to Kigali Airport for short flight to **Bujumbura, Burundi**.

A landlocked country in Central Africa, **Burundi** shares its south-western border with **Lake Tanganyika**, one of the deepest and longest freshwater lakes in the world. The combination of natural wonders and cultural depth makes Burundi a destination worth visiting for those seeking a glimpse into the diverse and intriguing mosaic of East Africa.

## 第02天

### 📍 抵达恩德培 - 坎帕拉 (1晚)

## 第04天

### 📍 伊丽莎白女王国家公园 - 黑猩猩追踪

上午进入神秘的尼安布拉峡谷展开**黑猩猩追踪**。丛林深处回荡着黑猩猩的叫声，或可见其灵活身影在林间跳跃。

## 第05天

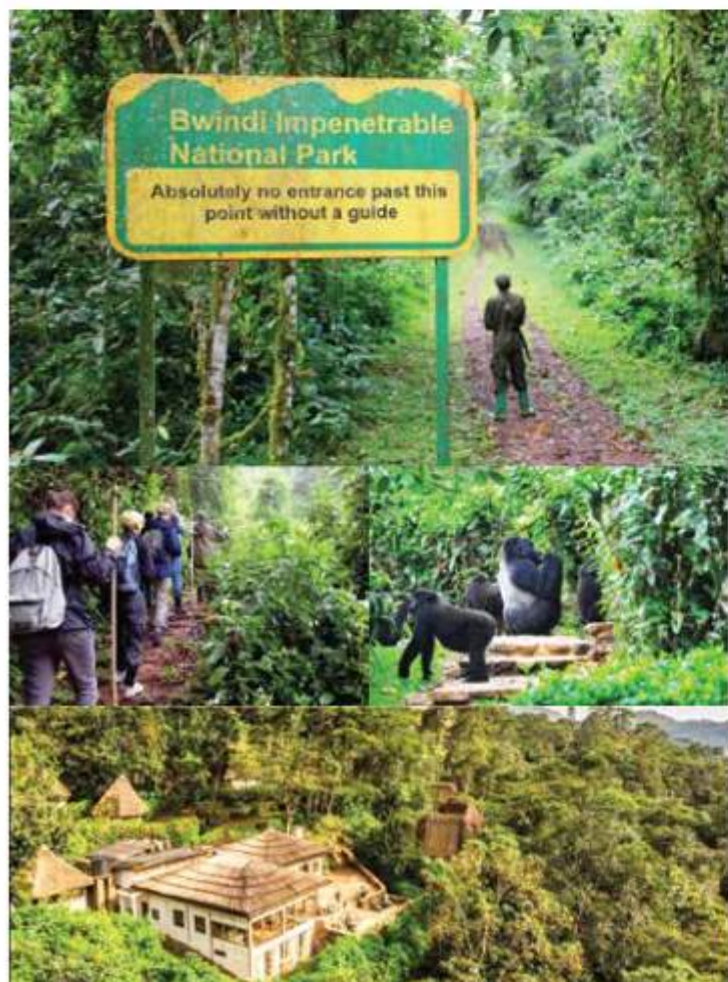
## 第06天



### 伊丽莎白女王国家公园 - 布恩迪原始森林国家公园（2晚）

早餐 / 午餐 / 晚餐

前往布恩迪原始森林国家公园——世界上大约一半濒危山地大猩猩的栖息地。驱车前往云雾弥漫的高地，道路蜿蜒通往的古老雨林。这里是乌干达著名的大猩猩高地的中心地带，栖息着全球约一半的濒危山地大猩猩。就植物种类而言，这里是乌干达最丰富的森林，因为该地区是东非少数几片低地与山地交汇的大片森林之一。旅程本身就是一个故事，每个转弯都展现着梯田、茶园和山景。明天，你将踏上地球上最伟大的冒险之一。



## 第07天



### 布恩迪原始森林国家公园 - 山地大猩猩徒步

早餐 / 午餐 / 晚餐

清晨前往公园总部集合，接受简报并分组进行定向指导，并根据您要追踪的大猩猩徒步旅行团进行分组。



在经验丰富的追踪者的带领下，徒步深入火山山坡上的森林，您将邂逅山地大猩猩家族。这些体型庞大的灵长类动物极为罕见。您将距离这些大猩猩家族仅几米之遥，并有幸与它们共度一段约一小时的美好时光。



追踪/徒步旅行（长达六小时或更长时间的情况并不少见）可能包括攀岩和徒步旅行；然而，当你与宁静而强大的山地大猩猩面对面时，观察着巨大的银背大猩猩、与母亲在一起的幼崽，以及大猩猩在你面前进行着它们的日常生活，这一切都令人无比震撼。

傍晚时分（如果时间允许），您可以漫步穿过社区，与当地人的见面，他们的传统和周围的森林一样丰富多彩。





## 第08天



### 布恩迪 - 卢旺达基伍湖 (1晚)

前往**卢旺达基伍湖**。基伍湖是非洲东非大裂谷的一部分，由卢旺达和刚果民主共和国共同拥有，四周环绕着雄伟的山脉，湖水碧绿如翡翠。

## 第09天

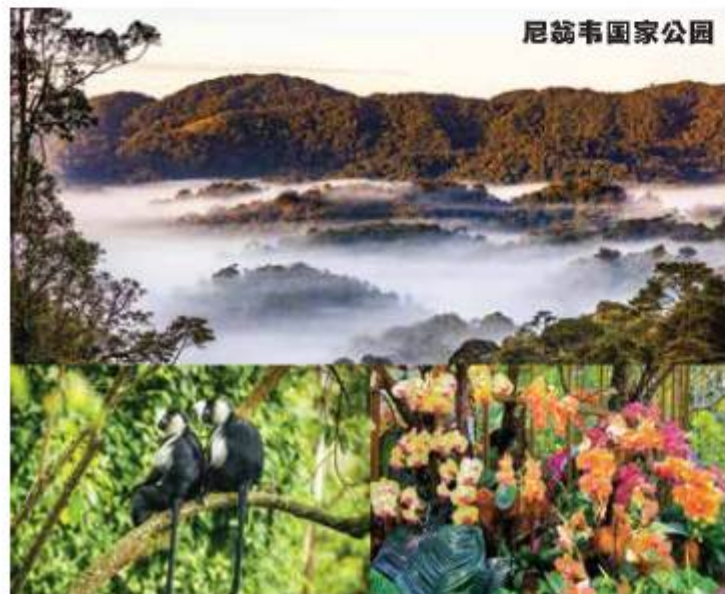


### 基伍湖 - 尼翁韦国家公园 (1晚)

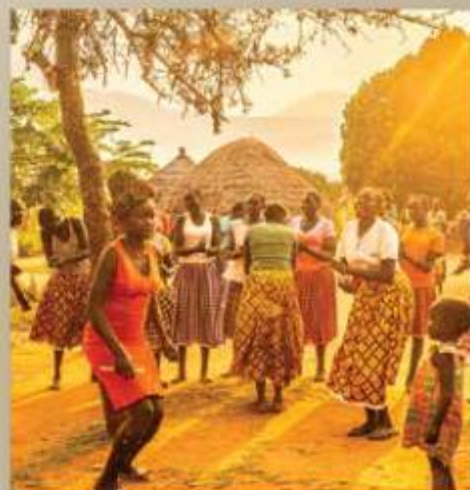
