
Day 02

Baghdad is the capital of Iraq. The population of Baghdad is approximately 9 million, making it the largest city in Iraq and the second largest city in the Arab world. Baghdad city excursions—National Museum & the Old City—Copper Market, Al Mutanabbi Café Shahbandar, Mustansiriya School. Traditional Fish Masgouf dinner.





Day 03



Excursion to the Martyr Monument (outside view if closed for repairs), Khadmiya Mosque and the Arch of Ctesiphon (outside view)—the world's largest brick-built arch, and the last structure still standing from an ancient Persian imperial capital of the same name.

In the afternoon, visit **Agargouf Kassite Ziggurat**. The ziggurat built by the Kassites is dedicated to the god Enlil – is an unusually well preserved building, with mud brick core that still stands to a height of about 170 feet on the flat plain in the vicinity of Baghdad.






Day 04

Baghdad > Iraqi Marshes > Ur > Nasiriyah (1N)

Early departure for a fun day as we explore the marshes, waterways, and unique lifestyle of southern Iraq. Enjoy a boat trip through the maze of marshes and stopping at local villages for tea. Tour the local market of Chibayesh. Continue to Ur, a major Sumerian city-state. Cuneiform tablets show that Ur was a highly centralized, wealthy, bureaucratic state during the third millennium B.C. See the home of the biblical Abraham.





Nasiriyah > Babylon > Najaf (1N)





Travel to the ancient city of Babylon and overnight in Najaf.

Babylon – the most famous ancient city in the whole World. It was the capital of ten Mesopotamian dynasties. Renowned for its high, well-fortified walls and for the magnificence of its temples and palaces. Its famous Hanging Gardens, built by King Nebuchadnezzar II and one of the Seven Wonders of the World.

Saadam Hussein's Palace next to Babylon.

On to **Kufa Mosque** then **Najaf** where Imam Ali is buried. It was in nearby Kufa in 661 that Imam Ali, the son-in-law of the Prophet Mohamed, was badly wounded and, as he lay dying, instructed his followers to strap his body to the back of a white camel and, where the camel stopped, to dig his grave. On this spot grew up the shrine city of Najaf, a place of pilgrimage for the Shia. Visit spectacular Iman Ali shrine.





Najaf > Kerbala > Baghdad (1N)

Visit Karbala – the Shrine city with Imam Hussein Shrine and Al Abbas Mosque. Continue to Ukhaider, the Islamic castle / palace.





Baghdad > Samarra > Hatra > Mosul (1N)

Samarra is one of the four Islamic Holy Cities of Iraq, and is considered as the largest ancient city known in the whole World with its majestic ruins along the eastern bank of the Tigris.

Samarra Mosque and Minaret – a dominating, magnificent structure that was once the largest mosque in the Islamic world built by Caliph Al-Mutawakkil in 852 AD using bricks and clay. The **Mosque's minaret** is the famous. Spiral which rises to a height of 52 m.

Hatra – a fortified city under the influence of the Parthian Empire and capital of the first Arab Kingdom, The remains of the city, especially the temples where Hellenistic and Roman architecture blend with Eastern decorative features, attest to the greatness of its civilization.





Day 08


Mosul > Al Qosh > Lalish
 Duhok, Kurdistan (1N)



Hotel Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner

Mosul is the second largest city in Iraq and in the process of rebuilding after being liberated from the Islamic State. Visit **Old Mosul** with its **souks and bazaar** and the **Immaculate Church**.

Proceed to **Al Qosh** to **Monastery of Rabban Hormuz**; the world's oldest monastery. Continue to **Shikhan** which has the **Lalish Temple** which is the most sacred temple for the **Yazidi** religion. Spend the afternoon here mingling and joining the festivities before overnighting in Duhok.











St Matthew Monastery famous for its magnificent library.

Amadiya – the stunning Kudish mountain village which is a cultural and historical gem. See Saddam's Hussein's former mountain top Palace.

Walk to the **Shanidar caves**, an archaeological site. Overnight **Erbil**, the capital of Kurdistan.








Erbil > Hamilton Road > Sulaymaniyah (1N)



Rwanduz Canyon is one of the most beautiful natural spots in Iraq. The countryside is pretty dramatic with snake like rivers moving between the canyons.

Drive on the **Hamilton Road** which connects Iraq with Iran. Built in the 1930's, it was an engineering marvel of its time. See the excavated **cave of Qzqapan**, which dates back to the Medes period. Overnight in **Sulamainyah** the second largest city in Kurdistan. In the evening, stroll **Saholka Street** – the street that never sleeps.

Our first stop today is **Halabja**, the scene of a chemical attack on the Kurdish civilians, perpetrated by the Baathist regime. Visit the memorial site. Visit **Dukan Lake** on the way to Erbil. Visit the village of **Koy Sanjaq** which is located in one of the most beautiful regions of Kurdistan.




第2天

游览**烈士纪念碑**(如果关闭维修,则外观赏)、卡德米亚 清真寺和泰西封拱门(观外)——世界上最大的砖砌拱门, 以及仍然矗立在同名古波斯帝国首都的最后一座建筑。 下午,参观Agargouf Kassite Ziggurat。卡斯特人建造的金字塔是献给恩利尔神的——是一座保存异常完好的建筑,泥砖芯仍然矗立在巴格达附近的平坦平原上约170英尺高。




第4天

◎ 巴格达 > 伊拉克沼泽 > 乌尔 > 纳西里耶 (1晚)



早餐/午餐/晚餐

早点出发,探索伊拉克南部的沼泽、水道和独特的生活方式。 **乘船游览邀宫般的沼**泽,并在当地村庄停下来喝茶。 参观Chibayesh的当地市场。继续前往乌尔,一个主要的 苏美尔城邦。楔形文字石板表明,乌尔在公元前三千年是 一个高度集中、富裕、官僚主义的国家。参观**圣经中亚伯 拉罕**的故乡。



◎ 纳西里耶 > 巴比伦 > 纳杰夫 (1晚)



早餐/午餐/晚餐

前往巴比伦古城,在纳杰夫过夜。

巴比伦 – 全世界最著名的古城。它是美索不达米亚十个 王朝的首都。以其高耸、坚固的城墙以及宏伟的寺庙和 宫殿而闻名。其著名的空中花园,由尼布甲尼撒二世国王 建造,是世界七大奇迹之一。

巴比伦旁边的萨达娅侯赛因宫殿。

前往**库法請真寺**,然后是伊玛目阿里被埋葬的纳杰夫。 661年,先知穆罕默德的女婿伊玛目阿里在附近的库法受 了重伤,在他垂死之际,指示他的追随者将他的尸体绑在 一头白骆驼的背上,在骆驼停下来的地方挖他的坟墓。 在这个地方长大了圣城纳杰夫,这是什叶派的朝圣之地。 参观壮观的伊曼阿里神社。萨达姆·侯赛因的宫殿毗邻 巴比伦。

◎ 巴格达 > 萨迈拉 > 哈特拉 > 摩苏尔(1晚)




早餐/午餐/晚餐

萨迈拉是伊拉克四大伊斯兰圣城之一,被认为是世界上最大的古城,其雄伟的废墟位于底格里斯河东岸。

萨迈拉清真寺和尖塔 — 一座宏伟的建筑,曾经是伊斯兰世界最大的清真寺,由哈里发穆塔瓦基尔于公元 852 年使用砖块和粘土建造。清真寺的尖塔很有名。螺旋上升到52 m的高度。

哈特拉 - 帕提亚帝国影响下的要塞城市,也是第一个阿拉伯王国的首都,这座城市的遗迹,尤其是希腊化和罗马建筑与东方装饰特色融为一体的寺庙、证明了其文明的伟大。


◎ 摩苏尔 > 库什 > 拉利什> 库尔德斯坦杜胡克(1晚)

前往Al Qosh,前往**拉班霍尔木兹修道院**;世界上最古老的修道院。继续前往Shikhan,那里有Lalish神庙,这是雅兹迪宗教最神圣的神庙。在这里度过一个下午,参加庆祝活动,然后在杜霍克过夜。










◎ 埃尔比勒 ➤ 汉密尔顿路 ➤ 苏莱曼尼亚(1晚)


