Baalbeck => Anjar => Ksara Wine Caves

Baalbeck —The Roman temples of Baalbeck makes up the largest and best preserved Roman architecture left around. The acropolis occupies the top of an artificial hill built up of different layers of habitation.

Anjar - was built in the early 8th century A.D. Inside the city's strong fortifications are the remains of streets, three palaces, souks, two hammams and a Mosque. It is located on the old route linking the Bekaa with Damascus.

Ksara Caves - were built during the Roman period then covered by sand for centuries, before found by mistakes in 1898 by the Jesuits. It is now the refuge of the famous Ksara wine where thousands of the old wine bottles are preserved. A tasting of the best wines is done during the visit.





Tyre "the Queen of the Seas", an island city of unprecedented splendor with five millennia of History. This great Phoenician city ruled the seas and founded prosperous colonies such as Cadiz and Carthage, but its historical role declined at the end of the Crusades. There are important archaeological remains, mainly from Roman times.

Sidon is one of the famous names in ancient history. Wander along the sea front and visit the **Crusader Sea Castle**. Not far from it is the picturesque vaulted **souk of Sidon** where workmen still play their trades. The **Khan el Franj** is a typical caravanserai with a large rectangular courtyard and a central fountain surrounded by covered galleries








Beirut City Tour - Martyrs' Square, National Museum, Pigeon Rock on the corniche & Parliament building.



Drive to the South of Beirut to visit the most enchanting area of Lebanon.

Deir al Qamar – a typical Lebanese village of stonehouses and red tiled roofs Surrounded by greenery & forests spread over seven hills of unequal picturesque beauty. It was residence of the Lebanese Governors for over 200 years. All around the main square, the Emirs built their palaces which were added to those inherited from their predecessors.

Beiteddine - with its arcades, galleries and rooms decorated by artists from Lebanon, Damascus and Italy, this building is a model of eastern architecture. Today the palace houses various museums

Early morning drive to Syria's capital; **Damascus** founded in the 3rd millennium B.C. and is one of the oldest continually inhabited city in the world.

Damascus City Tour Part I – the **Umayyad Mosque**, which is named for Islam's first ruling dynasty, and is one of the great monuments to the ingenuity of early Islam, **Saladin's Mausoleum & Souq Al Hamidiyeh**, the bustling covered bazaar that fills the senses with colours and life.



Damascus City Tour Part II – the **National Museum** which houses the finest collection of archaeological artifacts from around the country; **the Azem Palace**, the luxurious home of the Ottoman governor; **legendary Street Called Straight** mentioned in the Bible, which spans the old city's length from East to West; the **Chapel of St. Ananias** and **Bab Touma**, the Christian quarter with its charming alleyways and handicraft shops.

Damascus ⇒ Sednaya ⇒ Crac des Chevaliers ⇒ Al Wadi

Drive to **Sednaya** famous for the **Lady of Sednaya Monastery**.

Continue to **Crac des Chevaliers (UNESCO Site)**, which was built by the Hospitaller Order of Saint John of Jerusalem from 1142 to 1271. With further construction by the Mamluks in the late 13th century, Crac des Chevaliers ranks among the best-preserved examples of Crusader castles.

Homs – see the rebuilding effort after the devastation of the war and **Khalid Ibn Al Waleed Mosque**

Drive to Syria's second largest city, **Aleppo** which looks back on an impressive history of nearly 8,000 years. Due to its key location connecting the Eastern and Western worlds, Aleppo has a reputation as a city of savvy traders and merchants. The city is slowly rebuilding from the ruins of the recent conflict.

Aleppo City Tour Part I – **Aleppo citadel**, an impregnable fortress and the finest example of Arab architecture in the Middle East, stands high above the city on a hill, Old City and Baron Hotel.

◎ 巴勒贝克 ⇒ 安贾尔 ⇒ 卡萨拉葡萄酒洞穴



早餐/午餐/晚餐

巴勒贝克 - 巴勒贝克的罗马神庙构成了最大,保存最完好的罗马建筑。雅典卫城占据了由不同居住层组成的人工山丘的顶部。

安贾尔-建于公元8世纪初,在城市坚固的防御工事内是街道,三座宫殿,露天市场,两个土耳其浴室和一座清真寺的遗迹。它位于连接贝卡和大马士革的旧路线上。

卡萨拉洞穴-建于罗马时期,然后被沙子覆盖了几个世纪,直到1898年被耶稣会士错误地发现。它现在是著名的 Ksara葡萄酒的避难所,保存了成千上万的旧酒瓶。参观期间将品尝最好的葡萄酒。

推罗"海洋女王",一座拥有五千年历史的空前辉煌的岛屿城市。这座伟大的腓尼基城市统治着海洋,建立了加的斯和迦太基等繁荣的殖民地,但其历史作用在十字军东征结束时下降。有重要的考古遗迹,主要来自罗马时代。

西顿一是古代历史上著名的名字之一。沿着海滨漫步,参观十字军海上城堡。离它不远处是风景如画的西顿拱形露天市场,工人仍然在那里做他们的生意。汗弗兰尼是一个典型的商队,有一个大的矩形庭院和一个中央喷泉,周围环绕着有盖的画廊。


贝鲁特城市之旅 - 烈士广场,国家博物馆,滨海路和议会 大楼上的鸽子岩。



驱车前往**贝鲁特南部**,参观黎巴嫩最迷人的地区。

Deir al Qamar - 一个典型的黎巴嫩村庄, 石屋和红瓦屋 顶被绿色植物和森林所环绕, 分布在七座风景如画的山 丘上。200多年来,它是黎巴嫩总督的住所。在主广场周围, 埃米尔建造了他们的宫殿, 这些宫殿被添加到从他们的前 辈那里继承下来的宫殿中。

拜特丁宫拥有拱廊,画廊和由黎巴嫩,大马士革和意大利 艺术家装饰的房间,这座建筑是东方建筑的典范。今天, 宫殿设有各种博物馆。





继续前往Crac des Chevaliers(联合国教科文组织遗址),该遗址由耶路撒冷圣约翰医院骑士团于1142年至1271年建造。随着马穆鲁克人在13世纪后期的进一步建设,Crac des Chevaliers成为保存最完好的十字军城堡之一。

霍姆斯 - 参观战争破坏后的重建工作和哈立德•伊本•瓦利德清真寺。

驱车前往**叙利亚第二大城市阿勒颇**,那里拥有近8000年的悠久历史。由于其连接东西方世界的关键位置,阿勒颇享有精明商人和商人之城的美誉。最近冲突这座城市正在从的废墟中慢慢重建。

阿勒颇城市之旅第一部分 - **阿勒颇城堡**是一座坚不可摧的 堡垒,也是中东阿拉伯建筑的最佳典范,高耸于城市上方 的山丘,旧城和男爵酒店。






